# SOUTHERN IDAHO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ANNOUNCES 10<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL OPERATION FACELIFT WINNERS

Shoshone, Dietrich and Gooding County take home awards in the 2020 downtown revitalization project

MAGIC VALLEY, ID – November 16, 2020 – Southern Idaho Economic Development is proud to announce the winners of the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Operation Facelift. The annual region-wide community revitalization project encourages Magic Valley cities to complete projects big and small to build community pride, inspire new business development and revitalize downtown areas. The 2020 Operation Facelift winners include:

- City of Dietrich: "Best Community Art Facelift" Dietrich's project was to repair and/or replace residents' mailboxes that are damaged and in need of a facelift. Volunteers painted the mailboxes and mailbox posts with colorful art selected by the owner (pictures below).
- Gooding County: "Best Placemaking Facelift" With the sponsorship funds, Gooding County purchased an electronic reader board for the entrance to the Gooding County Fairgrounds. The reader board will be used to spread the word about activities in the community (pictures below).
- **City of Shoshone: "Best Small Business Facelift"** Shoshone's project included power washing, scraping and painting three downtown buildings in need of a facelift (*pictures below*). The project will also include adding benches throughout the downtown area, which will be built by FFA students in Shoshone.

"This was an unprecedented year for Operation Facelift, where we had more communities participate in the program and a record-breaking amount of sponsors, despite the challenges presented due to the pandemic," said Connie Stopher, Executive Director of Southern Idaho Economic Development. "This annual project is indicative of our region's dedication to helping one another and our strong business community that is committed to Southern Idaho's success."
